Foundation Year - History:	<p>Under the 388 law of 1914, the institution changed its name to National Technical University of Athens and becomes equal to the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens. The 49 articles of the Royal Order of 1915 clearly declare the role of the institution. Articles 24, 25, 26, 32 refer to the role of the library of the institution.</p> <p>In 1924 the first systematic catalogue of the library is published, which includes approximately 7.000 volumes. During the decade of 1940-1950 the library of the institution counts for around 40.000 volumes, while the Rector at the time, N. Kitsikis, hires temporary personnel to document the library's material.</p> <p>In 2000 as a statement year the library was transferred into a new building at the center of the campus, to a 7 floor building and it is one of the best-structured libraries in the country. Based on the laws 1268/1982 and 1404/1983 in every higher educational institution there should be a central library to facilitate research and teaching purposes and it will be an independent and self-contained organization.</p> <p>Overall to this day within the institution are registered and available 240.000 volumes of books</p>

100.000 volumes of journals.

The Central Library of the Institution provides service for the faculty and students, many of the technical staff and students from other institutions, external associates and the rest of the employees of the institution.

Collections:

The print bibliographic collections of the Central Library of NTUA are open access material, except the material of the closed access collections.

Main Collection: The main collection constitutes the larger segment of the books of the Central Library, counting more 100.000 book volumes. This information material, meaning lexicons, cyclopedias and handbooks cannot be loaned.

Old Editions: Is compiled of books, published between 1950 and 1970.

Political Library of Postgraduate Students Party NTUA: Includes books of political, social and historical content.

Theatrical Team books: Is compiled of theatrical plays of Greek and foreign creators.

Hellenic Open University books: Includes teaching material for the classes of the Hellenic Open University. Not loanable.

Multiple Bibliography books: It is the result of an older attempt to collect the suggested books of the NTUA classes.

Eudoxos collection of teaching material: It is set up according to the regulation 2377/2012 for the long term loaning of teaching material. It includes titles recommended from faculty members of NTUA to Eudoxos platform.

Printed journals collection: Is compiled of 1460 titles of Greek and foreign languages titles of

scientific journals. Not loanable.

Theses and Dissertations Collection: Includes the thesis and dissertation papers of the NTUA students up to 2005.

Services:

- **Loan:** NTUA Library functions as a loaning library for all the members of the university's community as well as the alumni of NTUA. To be able to borrow any material is necessary to have a library card. The loan duration depends on the kind of material, user's relationship with the institution (undergrad, postgrad, PhD, research associate, technical and administrative staff and faculty. The relationship of the users with the institution is verified by showing their library card, which is strictly personal. People who don't have a library card are not allowed to borrow any material, but are welcome to use the library's resources (electronic or print) within the premises, as well as to make photocopies of the printed material of their interest.
- **Interlibrary loan:** The Central Library of NTUA to fully address the research needs of the NTUA academic community and to enhance the educational process offers the opportunity for interlibrary loans. All members of the NTUA community have the opportunity to use this service as long as are registered members of the library. Via this service users have access to bibliographic material which is not included in the collections of neither the Central library nor its subsidiaries, while it supplies other partner libraries with material. Each user of this service can request photocopies of journal articles, templates and parts of monographs. Furthermore, they can borrow theses and dissertations.
- **Information Literacy Workshops:** These workshops aim to teach undergraduate and postgraduate students of NTUA how to

approach an individual or group assignment in a specific subject and also how to approach their thesis or dissertation. Additionally, the IL workshops address towards all NTUA members who wish to attain knowledge and skills regarding search patterns, resource evaluation, ethical use of information, copy rights, plagiarism, cv structure, gather and project publications etc.

- **Group study rooms:** There are six (6) rooms for group studying on the second floor of the Central Library at Zografou campus and are available for groups of three or more people for up to three hours. These rooms are suitable for group study or group assignments.
- **User training seminars:** These training seminars address all NTUA Central Library members, they last for 30 minutes and they aim to: (a) familiarize members with the space of the library, so they can orientate easily within the premises and through the collections, (b) train members on how to search in the library catalogue (OPAC), emphasizing in search techniques and personalized services provided due to the library card.
- **Tours:** Because of the public nature of the library, tours in the premises for schools and other organizations are often offered.

Collections and services (providing differentiation from other libraries of the network)

- **Historical Collection of NTUA:** This is the outcome of a systematic effort to reconstitute the old collection of the Institutional Library. 60.000 volumes of books and journals (1096 titles) have been classified from the 17th century until 1950. The majority of the collection is constituted of old and rare books, brochures, maps, graves and encyclopedias. This collection is not for loan.
- **Government Gazette:** It is the collection of this newspaper since 1872 until this day. It is not for loan.
- **Historical Collection of the Architecture and Fine Arts schools:** It includes approximately 3.600 books and 2.000 journal volumes published prior to 1950.
- **“K. A. Doxiadis” Collection in**

Bouboulinas Building (5th floor): In December of 1998 the National Technical University of Athens accepted an important donation. It is the well-known collection of the Athenian Residential Centre, which was donated to the NTUA by Emma and Constantine Doxiadis foundation. This collection, which supported the research and educational activity of the Athenian Technological Group and the Athenian Residential Centre, as well as the study activity of Doxiadis's office, was for decades the main reference of the technical communities of the country and is perceived as very important in its kind internationally. This donation is housed as a special collection under the title "K. A. Doxiadis Collection" on the 5th floor of Bouboulinas building at the Patision campus. The collection includes over about 20.000 monographs mainly regarding Residential subjects, but it also includes Social Science, Mathematics, Physical Science, Applied Science, Town Planning, Architecture, Geography and History subjects. This collection is open to the public, but not loanable.

- **Institutional Repository:** It constitutes the digital collection of NTUA, containing theses, dissertations and PhDs conducted within the institution and it is obligatory to be submitted in the repository. It also includes publications from faculty members of the academic community in journals and conferences, etc. and it aims to gather the entire digital activity of the institution.

Services provided for the members of the network and its readers:

All of our services addressed to the members of the university that are not necessarily loanable, as it is not foreseen in the current loan regulation, but with the intent to be altered after the approval from the management of the institution.

Staff and specialties:

19 permanent and tenured librarians, including 1 PhD, 5 postgraduates and 4 soon to be postgraduates.

1 librarian under temporary contract, soon to be a postgraduate.
